Maple Community Services is proud to award two inaugural scholarships to individuals within the disability sphere in Australia. These two scholarships are positioned to provide both the Maple Community as well as the broader disability industry, opportunities for supported education.

Maple Emerging Talent Scholarship

The Maple Emerging Talent Scholarship is an initiative designed to assist individuals within the Maple Family grow and expand their education. This Scholarship is open to any Maple individual - whether it be staff or client, who has been with the company for more than 3 months.

Maple Equality & Inclusion Scholarship

The Maple Equality and Inclusion Scholarship has been established to help provide people with a disability, greater access to affordable educational opportunities. This Scholarship is open to any individual within the Australian Community who identifies as having a primary disability.



Key Aspects

Eligibility

Eligibility for each Scholarship varies, with the major difference being:

- Maple Emerging Talent Scholarship is for Maple Clients and Staff.
- The Maple Equality & Inclusion Scholarship is for any persons within Australia who identifies as having a primary disability.

Tenure

The Tenure Period for the 2023 Maple Scholarship Program is 1 year, running from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023. This means that successful applicants have a 12-month period to complete their proposed study with Maple's support.

The Selection Process



STEP 1

Application Submissions

are open between Monday August 1, 2022 & Friday November 18, 2022. Applications should include a completed Application Form, Proof of Enrolment, and a Reference.



STEP 2

Interview Rounds

Selection Committee will review applications, conduct a round of interviews and complete reference checks if required between November 28 & December 26.



STEP 3

Notifying of Applicants.

Successful applicants will be announced on or before the 23rd of December 2022, with all other applicants also notified.



Use of funds

The Scholarship Funds are available for individuals to utilise on aspects that will assist them to complete their studies successfully. Examples of this include: Course Fees, Transport, IT Requirements, Resources, Course Excursions, On-Campus Costs, Tutoring, and so on.
